Energy use covers the operations of office and warehouse premises and the installation, removal and maintenance of gas meters.

To reduce the impact of CO2 emissions we purchased green gas to offset emissions from our gas consumption of 23,275 Kg of CO2.

After year end, we replaced the heating and air conditioning system at Regent House. The new system will be more energy efficient and will only use electricity. Solar panels with a

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capacity of 42.93 kWp were installed on part of the roof at Regent House. Also after year end, a warehouse was purchased for the operations of our metering business. Solar panels with a capacity of 26.3kWp have been installed and a combined heat and power system is due to be installed in the next few months.

We expect these energy saving measures to have some impact in FY2021 but a more significant impact in FY2022.
